

All Knoxville Figure Skating Club and Learn to Skate members are encouraged to sign up.

Solos are open to KFSC members (high school seniors or younger) who have an axel and have passed USFS Juvenile Moves in the Field, or ISI FS 5 and above. High School class of 2022 skaters are guaranteed a solo, regardless of level and do not need to submit a video. The audition video may be from a previous competition and should be a maximum of 90 seconds long and must include an axel and at least one combination spin. The audition does not need to be to the music you would like for the show. Include your choice of show music with your audition. Videos are due by October 15th and may be emailed to knoxskating@gmail.com. If you are unable to email the video please send a message to knoxskating@gmail.com and we will make other arrangements. If you are selected for a solo the fee will be \$25.

Duos, trios, quartets and group numbers are open to skaters of all ages and levels, including Learn to Skate.

Duets, trios, and quartets will be \$15 per skater and group numbers will be \$10 per skater. All fees are due at the first rehearsal. Coaching fees for solos, duos/trios/quartets are at the discretion of your coach and are independent of the show fee..

Music choice must be submitted, in signup genius or by email to knoxskating@gmail.com, with the name of the song and artist. Songs should be appropriate for all ages. Approval will be granted on a first come first serve basis. Each song will only be allowed once.

Group numbers - rehearsal and coaches will be determined after registration and every effort will be made to accommodate the skater's schedules.

Costumes are not included in the show fee.
