SafeSport Certifications must be renewed for the 21/22 membership year.

The USFS program is called Skate Safe but the certification is still SafeSport.

The renewal is shorter than the initial certification. Current Certifications and memberships expire in June.

Every adult member must be Safe Sport certified. If the member is under 18, an adult family member must be Safe Sport certified. You must login to https://usfsaonline.org/ and click on the Skate Safe Logo

Age: 13


Current Coaches: Su Wagner is my head coach. I also work with Corinne Oliphant and Hannah Foust

November 13th




