

Sora is always a joy to be around and never fails to hype you up.



To further applaud the achievements of the individuals awarded, U.S. Figure Skating will publish the names of the recipients on the U.S. Figure Skating Graduating Seniors Award Program webpage. An article about the award will be published in SKATING Magazine in the Spring.

To be considered for this award, applicants must complete an online application. The application is available on U.S. Figure Skating's Members Only website on the "Graduating Seniors Page" on the "Programs" menu dropdown.

Application Timeline:

- Application opens: no later than September 1, 2023
- Early application deadline (to list award on college applications): October 2, 2023
- General application deadline: March 18, 2024
- Late application deadline: June 30, 2024

All deadlines are as of 11:59pm MT. No applications will be accepted after the close of the 2023-24 U.S. Figure Skating membership year on June 30, 2024.

Following each application deadline and review process by U.S. Figure Skating, the Graduating Questions regarding this program can be directed to Chloe Roberts, School and Alumni Programs Manager, at <u>croberts@usfigureskating.org</u>.

The test Structure is one of the most important and rewarding parts of figure skating. All U.S. Figure Skating members from recreational and competitive skaters can participate.

Figure skating in the U.S. can be either competitive or recreational, and those learning to skate can choose either route. While competitive skaters are required to participate in the U.S. testing structure to eventually compete in qualifying competitions, recreational skaters can also opt to take tests in order to continually challenge themselves and their abilities.

The official tests of U.S. Figure Skating may be taken by all figure skaters who are members of a member club or collegiate club, individual members who are currently registered with U.S. Figure Skating and are otherwise qualified under these rules, as well as by members of a member association of the ISU.

Test sessions can only be held under the auspices and control of a member club. Fees are involved and vary by club. Clubs do not need a sanction to hold a test session.

Sessions are organized and run under procedures outlined in the U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook. Any person who is interested in participating in the U.S. Figure Skating testing structure should review the <u>U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook</u>, which addresses information such as the types of tests offered, the elements on each test, how tests are marked, which judges are required, age requirements for different test categories and conduct of coaches and candidates at test sessions.

The order in which tests are taken is important. According to Rule 4002 in the rulebook: "A candidate shall not be eligible to take a higher-level test until all of the preceding tests in the same category have been passed or completed except as otherwise specified in these rules."

As a way for U.S. Figure Skating to congratulate skaters for passing tests at the novice level or higher, we will write a personalized school recognition letter (in .pdf format) that can be forwarded to teacher(s) and/or principal, school leadership, etc. The letter will be personally addressed to them, will include the skater's name, the test passed and information about what this test means to the athlete's skating career and resumé.

These letters are generated in a "mail merge" format on U.S. Figure Skating letterhead, based upon the information entered into the form found at the link below. They will be e-mailed as an attachment to the skater or parent/guardian. Student-athletes may request as many letters for as many different people as necessary, however, a separate form MUST be completed for EACH personalized letter. Please note: letters will only be written for skaters who submit a form within **2 months** of passing a test.



#### The USFS program is called Skate Safe but the certification is still SafeSport.

The renewal is shorter than the initial certification. Current certifications and memberships expire in June.

Every adult member must be Safe Sport certified. If the member is under 18, an adult family member must be Safe Sport certified. You must login to <a href="https://usfsaonline.org/">https://usfsaonline.org/</a> and click on the Skate Safe Logo
